About Us

overview

We're an Anglican church in the heart of Charleston.

The Cathedral is located on 126 Coming Street in Radcliffeborough, a downtown neighborhood in the center of the peninsula. We seek to cultivate Christ's likeness in our common life for the common good. We love to keep our doors wide open to our neighbors. All that is ours comes from the Lord God who gives good gifts (James 1:17).

We share our space for events of various scale, from small group working sessions to large concerts or weddings and everything in between. Our historic sanctuary, restored portico, vibrant courtyard, modern parish hall and kitchens, and classrooms are intentionally designed to welcome and inspire creativity.

We have a number of spaces in a variety of sizes to accommodate your group, along with the audio-visual equipment and an event coordinator for support leading up to your gathering. Our sanctuary can sit over 400 people and we can fit more than 10 6ft. round tables in our parish hall.

The Cathedral was built in 1811 in the Early Greek and Gothic Revival styles. Our parish hall is modern with classic Charleston charm. We are a 5 minute walk to the corner of Calhoun and King. Our facility is open for rent Monday to Friday from 8 am until 9 pm and Saturdays from 9 am until 10 pm. Accessibility Notice

We are in the process of constructing an ADA ramp for entrance and exit into the Cathedral Sanctuary. It will be ready in 2026. Currently, we offer an outdoor elevator to enter or exit the Sanctuary. It operates beside the side door facing the courtyard. Wellbrock Hall and the Courtyard spaces are on level accessible ground when entering the property through the Vanderhorst St. gate.

Sanctuary



Our Sanctuary is a beautiful space for both traditional and modern weddings, lecture series, prayer services, concerts and more. The acoustic properties alone make it a sought after space for the Spoleto Festival. Our bell tower is equipped with 8 bells and our organ is fully functioning and regularly tuned. The seating capacity exceeds 400 with the option to include balcony seating.

Courtyard



Our Courtyard is frequently used for lunch or dinner receptions and entertainment such as concerts and movie nights. Our peaceful fountain, green space, shading myrtles, and kids playground make for an elevated “backyard party” feel in the heart of downtown. Standing capacity is more than 200.

Wellbrock Hall



Wellbrock Hall is a multi-function space for learning, meeting, or entertaining.

It is a common luncheon or wedding reception venue with the capacity to seat 6-8 people at 10-12 6ft round tables. In one corner of the hall, there is a furnished den area with couches and chairs. Beautiful fig trees grow on mobile planters and local photography lines the walls.

We have hosted lectures and panels, private lessons and tutoring, children's care, corporate gatherings, and breakout sessions. Additionally, this space could serve as a small dance/music hall or temporary art exhibit.

Groups & Meetings

Red/Blue Rooms & Conference Room



For small groups needing classroom- or boardroom-style arrangements, our red and blue rooms or our conference room would be great options. These rooms sit between 10 and 15 people. We will provide presentation equipment, printing services, wi-fi, and coffee.

Parking

Coming Street Parking Lot



Our "Coming Street Lot" is included in all event reservations. This lot is directly across from the church portico between Vanderhorst and Warren St. and includes around 50 spots. The Event Coordinator will specify instructions for your group.

During the week, our lot is a public paid parking space. However, for special events we will reserve the lot, either partially or entirely, for your guests.

If the need for parking exceeds the capacity of the Cathedral's Coming Street lot, it is the responsibility of the lessee to accommodate guests.

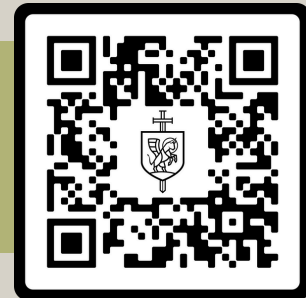
There is no attendant, but you may either inquire about one or provide your own parking attendant who abides by Cathedral policies.

The Cathedral does not host destination weddings. We are happy to make recommendations if this is your case. Weddings celebrated at the Cathedral must have an obvious connection to the Cathedral family or persons have an imminent desire to be connected to the Cathedral as future parishoners. The Cathedral may also partner with church plants in hosting a ceremony for a body of believers without a permanent or traditional church building.

All weddings conducted at the Cathedral are to be Christian weddings. You may wish to read more about the ACNA's theology of marriage. It is expected that the couple will contact the officiating priest for Premarital Counseling. If this is a non-member wedding and an off-site pastor/priest is officiating, that pastor/priest must contact the Cathedral's Dean to assure them of the couple's commitment to premarital counseling. An initial meeting with the pastor/priest should be scheduled no later than 6 months before the wedding to allow ample time for the required counseling.

Dates: All wedding requests must be submitted 6 months prior to the desired date.

Vows: Neither the priest nor the couple is free to alter the service beyond the permissible options as found within the Book of Common Prayer, which do not allow for writing one's own vows.

Wedding Planning and Coordinating: The Cathedral Church does not supply a planner or day-of coordinator. The Cathedral does provide an onsite staff person, the Cathedral Events Coordinator, for the duration of the event to ensure smooth set-up and clean-up. Couples are required, at the least, to have their own day-of coordinator who is aware of all Cathedral event policies and who will be the point of contact for all third party vendors.

Alcohol Policy: Unless the reception is held in Wellbrock Hall, alcohol is not permitted on the property. At the reception, beer and wine is allowed (no liquor) and non-alcoholic options must be provided. Bartenders must submit their license, and the Cathedral is not liable.

Decorations: Other than the traditional service candelabras or the Eucharistic altar candles, no candles (flame or faux) may be used anywhere in the Sanctuary or parish hall unless for a reception in Wellbrock where candles may be lit only if contained in glass. White silk altar hangings are provided and High Altar floral arrangements may be requested for an additional fee.

Music: The Cathedral's piano or organ may be requested for use at an additional fee on top of the required sound engineer fee. Furthermore, we are happy to suggest a professional player. All music must be prepared in advance and approved by the officiant.

Booking & Deposit

After an event is approved, a lease will be signed and deposit collected. Weddings require a deposit 6 months in advance. Other events require 1 to 3 months deposit.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation policies vary by event type. The lease will state the amount of advance cancellation notice required to receive back a portion of or all of the deposit paid.

Insurance

All external event vendors are required to present insurance to the Cathedral. The Cathedral Church of St. Luke and St. Paul is not liable for behavior or safety of those in attendance at your event.
